PENANG HILL FESTIVAL 2024 (PHF2024): CELEBRATING NATURE, **CULTURE, EDUCATION & MUSIC**

The much-anticipated annual **Penang Hill Festival (PHF)** returns from **19 to 21 July** 2024, promising an enriching and educational experience for visitors. Since its inception in 2018, the Penang Hill Festival has been growing from strength to strength, uniting businesses, hill community, academics, artists, and nature enthusiasts in celebrating the multi-cultural splendour of Penang Hill.

This year's highlights include the Penang Hill Songwriting Competition with the theme "Penang Hill - A Treasured Gem", organised in collaboration with Cadenza Music & Performing Arts Academy, which will provide a platform for aspiring local talents to showcase their musical flair and creativity. The winning entry will be selected as the official theme song of Penang Hill, resonating with visitors for years to come.

The competition is open to all Malaysians aged 15 years old and above, encouraging submissions across a spectrum of musical genres that reflect Malaysia's rich cultural tapestry. Entry is free, offering an inclusive platform for budding musicians to exhibit their talent and passion. This presents a great opportunity for our local talents to shine, showcasing their creativity while embodying the diverse cultural heritage and musical essence of our beloved Penang.

The champion will receive RM3,000, 1st runner-up RM1,500, 2nd runner-up RM800, and there will be three (3) Awards of Excellence. each accompanied by a trophy and a certificate of achievement for the winners. The registration period for the competition is from 18th April to 17th June 2024, and submissions will be accepted from **18th June to 31st July 2024**. All budding musicians and talents are encouraged to join this competition.

"This year's Penang Hill Festival holds special addition, injecting a sense of rejuvenation and essence to the festival as we celebrate the talents and music," shares YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow, Chief Minister of Penang. "In addition to the array of enriching activities, the introduction of the Penang Hill Songwriting Competition underscores PHC's commitment to encouraging talents and providing them with a platform to showcase their creativity".

Alongside the competition, PHF2024 promises an array of exciting programmes, including Talks, Heritage and Nature Discovery Walks, Exhibitions, Photography Workshops, and the much-anticipated "Music on the Hill - East meets West" on 21 July 2024. The festival aims to enhance heritage and biodiversity education while fostering a deeper appreciation for Penang Hill's cultural and ecological significance.

Attendees will also get to enjoy captivating performances by local talents such as Penang Youth Orchestra, highlighting young musical prowess, and Sada Borneo, a Malaysian band formed in Penang in 2013. Comprising six members from various parts of Malaysia, Sada Borneo blends traditional, modern, ethnic, and nature elements to create a new sound for Malaysian music. The band gained popularity for representing Malaysia in AXN's Asia's Got Talent 2015, reaching the Semi Final stage, and airing in 20 countries across Asia. Sada Borneo has also received other prestigious awards.

Among the other main highlights of **PHF2024** are the insightful talks focusing on key topics such as the remarkable transformation of Penang Hill and the pressing issue of illegal wildlife trapping in the Penang Hill Biosphere Reserve (PHBR). Moreover, nature enthusiasts can immerse themselves in enlightening experiences such as guided walks along the Viaduct Trail, Moniot Trail, and Crag Heritage Trail, offering opportunities to discover the rich history and diverse flora and fauna of Penang Hill.

Families with children aged five to 15 can engage in the Junior Rainforest **Exploration**, designed to nurture curiosity and passion for nature while providing hands-on learning experiences. Additionally, other interesting explorations such as Herbs Exploration offer insights into the different types of herbs found on the hill, while **Night Exploration** provides a unique experience to explore the hill's nocturnal world.

In addition to talks and walks, attendees can indulge in photography workshops hosted by Canon Malaysia, focusing on bird photography as well as nature and macro photography. These workshops offer valuable tips and techniques from professional photographers, allowing participants to capture stunning images amidst the breathtaking scenery of Penang Hill.
