PENANG HILL RAILWAY CELEBRATES 100th ANNIVERSARY WITH A DECORATIVE ARTWORK AT THE AIR ITAM ROUNDABOUT

In commemoration of **Penang Hill Railway's 100**th **Anniversary** - a century of service - the Air Itam main roundabout is decorated as one of the highlights of its centenary celebration.

This memorable occasion echoes a joint effort between YB Joseph Ng, State Assemblyman for Air Itam, the OHM Group, and Penang Hill Corporation, who have collaborated to decorate the iconic roundabout and commemorate the historic centenary of the Penang Hill Railway.

The region known as Air Itam (or Ayer Itam / Ayer Hitam), which derived its name from the murky water of the Air Itam River, had its beginnings in the late 18th century shortly after the establishment of Penang Island by Captain Francis Light in 1786. The British administration harboured intentions of transforming Air Itam, including Penang Hill, into a thriving agricultural hub and spice farms.

To this day, fruits and vegetables are still grown at the hill, and fresh produce is then brought downhill to the wet markets. This illustrates the strong connection between Penang Hill and Air Itam, where the funicular was the lifeline for the farmers to bring down their products during the early days.

Since the completion of the funicular railway in 1923 and the urbanisation of Air Itam from the 1950s, the area has undergone significant transformations. Visitors, the community, and stakeholders have become interdependent, contributing to socio-economic development in the surrounding areas.
