Penang Hill Festival 2023 Celebrates the Century-Year-Old Railway

The annual Penang Hill Festival returns this year for the fourth edition from 21-23 July 2023! Since its inception in 2018, Penang Hill Festival has collaborated with business partners, the hill community, academics, artists and nature enthusiasts to bring together an event suited for everyone.

The three-day festival is aimed at promoting and creating greater awareness of Penang Hill's nature, history and cultural heritage. Furthermore, Penang Hill Festival 2023 (PHF2023) is extra meaningful as it also highlights and celebrates the 100th anniversary of the Penang Hill Railway which began its operations in 1923.

"I am happy to announce that Penang Hill Corporation (PHC) will once again organise the popular Penang Hill Festival this year. This annual festival offers visitors and locals a glimpse of Penang Hill's uniqueness from its century-year-old railway, to its lush greenery rich biodiversity that was certified as a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve site in 2021," says YB Yeoh Soon Hin, Penang State EXCO for Tourism and Creative Economy (PETACE).

"We hope this festival will boost heritage and biodiversity education in Penang and draw greater appreciation towards our nation's icon, the Penang Hill. Visitors can expect an array of exciting and interesting programmes ranging from Talks, Heritage and Nature Discovery Walks, Exhibitions, Photography & Videography Workshops and not forgetting Penang Hill Festival's signature event; "Music on the Hill - East meets West" on 22 July 2023," YB Yeoh added.

Some of the highlights include: -

Talk: Rejuvenating Penang Hill: The Journey Continues... i.

A freak storm on 4 November 2017 badly affected Penang Hill, resulting in more than 300 landslides on the Hill alone. Huge boulders, fallen trees, and debris were everywhere, cutting off access roads. The funicular service was also disrupted then.

What had been done to rectify the effects of the landslides? What were the challenges faced? Learn about these at the talk session - "Rejuvenating Penang Hill: The Journey Continues..." by Lngeshwary a/p Bhaskaran and Muhamad Sahrizan bin Sepiai – who spearhead Penang Hill Corporation's Project Planning & Development Division, Ir. ii. <u>Talk: Penang Hill & Its Vicinity: 100 Years of Wonders</u>

This year, as we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Penang Hill Funicular Railway, learn about the numerous wonders in and around Penang Hill from our speakers at the talk session -"Penang Hill & Its Vicinity: 100 Years of Wonders".

Come join Enzo Sim - the author of "The Great Hill: A Short History of Penang Hill", Clement Liang – a history researcher active in promoting heritage conservation and tourism, and Dr. Tan Chee Seng – a Senior Lecturer at the History Section, School of Humanities, Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), as these experts share the historical evolution of Penang Hill, the transformation of the Air Itam/Air Putih valley, and the "education wonders" across centuries since the early 19th century, to discover the pioneers of education in Malaysia, around Penang Hill.

iii. Talk & Walk: Crag Heritage Trail

Step back in time and experience the vibrant past of Penang Hill with a visit to The Crag, a historical landmark on the Hill that has withstood the test of time. Built in the mid-19th century, The Crag served many purposes over the years, from a sanitarium to a hotel and a boarding school. This iconic building was even the filming site for "Indochine" in 1992 and a British TV series, "Indian Summers", in 2014.

Take a 3-km nostalgic stroll along the Crag Heritage Trail while indulging yourself in the memories of Penang Hill. If you are an Uplands alumnus, it will be appealing to find out more about your alma mater and relive some of your fondest memories!

iv. Night Exploration

A rare chance to see the nocturnal wonders of the Penang Hill rainforest! In deep darkness, surrounded by jungle sounds, you will enter a world inhabited by diverse night creatures. Many animals, especially insects, amphibians, and reptiles, hide from predators during the day. This means that night is the best time to find beautiful frogs, shy snakes, and other rainforest creatures that only come out when the sky turns dark. You never know what miraculous creatures you will encounter!
